Sister to Sister International (STSI)

Nationally, maternal mortality is 3 to 4 times higher for Black women than for White women. STSI is being honored for successfully elevating and promoting Black maternal health as a key public health issue in Westchester, New York State and nationally. Through partnerships with Black and Brown birthing people, healthcare, academia, elected officials and the general public, and their seminal research report, *Still I Rise: The Status of Black Women and Girls in Westchester County (2019)*, STSI is leading the way on solutions to this and other problems resulting from the social determinants of health and systemic racism.
