Position Description Summary: DOROT Westchester is poised for growth and is looking for a part time social worker to work with seniors as well as recruit for and manage volunteer opportunities and programs. Primary Responsibilities:

- Perform in-home assessments and annual reassessments for a caseload of 24 clients
- Recruit, screen, interview and orient volunteers for DOROT programs and services, supporting a 10% increase in volunteer participation
- Increase awareness about DOROT throughout Westchester County
- Liaise with Volunteer Services Department in Manhattan to coordinate the annual Cemetery Visit program for Westchester, Holiday Package Delivery and other collaborative volunteer opportunities
- Work on special projects and duties as assigned by Director
- Attend meetings at DOROT and in the county as needed
