

Swim Instructor – Special Needs

The YWCA White Plains and Central Westchester is currently seeking a part time Swim Instructor for children with Special Needs. The Swim Instructor provides ability specific progressive swim instruction to a diverse population of consumers who have developmental disabilities or other limitations that make participation in group swim lessons impractical. The Swim Instructor is under the direct and coordinated supervision of the program supervisor in which the activity is provided.

Candidate will be scheduled to work four hours on a Sunday. Hourly pay rate will range from \$20 – \$35 depending on experience.

- Thorough knowledge and application of teaching swimming and water safety skills
- Leadership and communication skills
- Ability to work consistent Sundays and be on time for scheduled shift.
- Ability to work independently and possess energy and enthusiasm.
- Ability to positively interact with the general public

Experience: One-year previous aquatics experience teaching swim, working with people who have disabilities.

Licensing and/or Certifications: American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification preferred.
