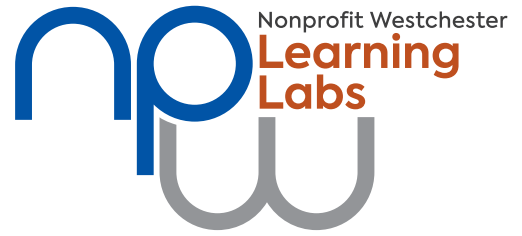


Financial Management Learning Lab
